**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:** No public comment


The Board of Supervisor, Washington Township, reviewed the current financial position of the Township before discussing the following goals for 2016:

1. Road Work
  - a. Complete Kemmerling Road
  - b. Sealcoat Birds Hill, Fiddlers, and Flat Hill Roads
  - c. Budget \$100,000 for misc. road repairs
2. Office Building
  - a. Building and furnishings
  - b. Doors for garage
  - c. HVAC upgrade for garage
  - d. Cable Internet
3. Equipment Purchase
  - a. Skid Loader
4. Bridge Repairs
  - a. 30% cost to the township if grants are approved estimated cost \$100,000

Supervisor Gainer instructed Secretary Koch to update the budget worksheet with estimated figures for the next township meeting to be reviewed.

**ADJOURNMENT:** There being no further business to come before the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, upon motion of Chairman Lutz, seconded by Supervisor Brown, the meeting adjourned at 8:06 p.m. This motion unanimously carried.
