

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
Work Session of August 15, 2022

The work session was called to order by Chairman Krause at 6:00pm. Those in attendance were Chairman John Krause, Supervisor Lynn Brown, and Township Manager Dawn Koch.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: There were no public comments.

DISCUSSION: Koch presented the Board with a copy of the updated 2022 proposed agreement from Comcast regarding the franchise fee. She stated the agreement is due in October. She stated within the next month the Board should review and ask any questions so that they can be discussed at the next meeting.

Koch presented the Board with Resolution 2020-6 pertaining to the Per Capita tax ordinance 2012-101. She stated the resolution defined the township's position on exemptions. Koch questioned if she should move forward with creating a new ordinance as previously instructed. The Board said agreed to proceed as instructed but present the proposed new ordinance with exemption choices to consider.

Road Master Lynn Brown informed the Board that the road crew will be patching potholes for the next few weeks.

Chairman Krause asked what the reasoning was for the increased cost on the Wild Cherry Cold in Place. Road Master Brown explained that the cost in oil increased from the time it was originally calculated in 2021 until it was completed in 2022.

ADJOURNMENT: The work session was adjourned, upon motion of Chairman Krause, seconded by Supervisor Brown at 6:43 p.m.
