

ORDINANCE NO. 72

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Washington Township Supervisors, that excessive speed of motor vehicles operating within the Township on Township Roads, has become a hazard to the safety of the general public, its individual citizens, and their personal property and real property; and

WHEREAS, under the Second Class Township Code, Washington Township Supervisors are charged with protecting the public safety and the property of its individuals; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration of the problem, it has been decided to limit the speed of motor vehicles on Washington Township Roads;

NOW THEREFORE, be it Enacted and Ordained that the maximum speed limits permitted by motor vehicles on the enumerated Washington Township Roads, shall be as follows:

1. The maximum speed of motor vehicles on the following Roads shall be 25 miles per hour.

25 MPH

- Washington Township Road T-801
- Washington Township Road T-802

2. Any one convicted of exceeding the maximum of speed limits, shall pay a fine of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars per violation if convicted thereof, together with the costs of prosecution.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after enactment hereof.
