ORDINANCE NO. 2002 - 1

AN ORDINANCE OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA SETTING THE COMPENSATION OF TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS.

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 60 of 1995, setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class, and;

**WHEREAS**, the act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of up to 4,999 may be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$1,875.00 per year, and;

**WHEREAS**, the population of Washington Township is less than 4,999 and;

**WHEREAS**, the General Assembly by Act 60 authorizes the board of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in the act,

Now, therefore it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

1. Each supervisor of Washington Township elected or appointed to office after the effective date of this ordinance shall receive compensation as a supervisor in the annual amount of \$ 1,875.00.
2. Such compensation shall be paid in quarterly installments.
3. Payment of compensation, per quarter, shall require the supervisor to attend two (2) meetings in the quarter for which the compensation may be payable.
4. Quarters shall be calendar quarters. First Quarter: January - March, Second Quarter: April - June, Third Quarter: July - September, Fourth Quarter: October - December.

5. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after its enactment.
