5. Information: Action taken by the supervisors on Monday, January 5, 2026.
 - a. Township Treasurer’s Bond- (Section 702 of the Township Code) the supervisors have set the amount at \$1,000,000.00 as approved at the reorganizational meeting.
 - b. Audit- The supervisors will appoint Garcia, Garman & Shea, PC to perform the 2025 annual audit. This no longer requires a resolution, unless the township changes who does the audit.
 - c. Meeting pay is set by the Township Code Section 606 with township population under 4,999. The annual maximum allowed is \$3,145.
