BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MEETING OF:
MARCH 16, 2026

The regular monthly meeting of the Washington Township Board of Supervisors was held on Monday, March 16, 2026.

Those in attendance were Chairman John J. Krause, Vice-Chairman Eric Wolfe, Supervisor Lynn Brown, Secretary/Treasurer Dwayne Kroh, and Solicitor Rick Wiest. Also in attendance were Nancy Welty, and Nick Miller.

Chairman Krause opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman Krause reminded the residents of the notices regarding meeting conduct and public comment procedures.

TREASURER’S REPORT AND BILLS FOR APPROVAL: Upon motion of Chairman Krause, seconded by Vice-Chairman Wolfe, the February 5, 2026 – March 4, 2026, Treasurer’s Report was approved with a balance in all accounts, before receipts and bills, of \$1,544,143.33. Included in this motion was the approval of payment of all bills presented. This motion unanimously carried.

RECEIPTS: The report of receipts (February 5, 2026 – March 4, 2026) listing \$62,509.05 in EIT receipts and \$4,386.48 in regular General Fund receipts was approved as printed upon motion of Chairman Krause, seconded by Vice-Chairman Wolfe. This motion unanimously carried.

ROADMASTER REPORTS: Roadmaster Brown stated Sunrise Rd and Frantz Rd are the two big road projects he is looking at this year.
